

Higher Education Emergency Relief Fund Reporting-
Emergency Financial Aid Grants to Students

1. Murray State College signed and returned the Certification and Agreement to the Department of Education. MSC intends to use no less than 50 percent of the funds received under Section 18004(a)(1) of the CARES Act to provide Emergency Financial Aid Grants to students.
2. Murray State College will receive \$583,905 from the Department of Education for Emergency Financial Aid Grants to Students.
3. As of May 20, 2020 Murray State College has not disbursed any funds to students. Funds are scheduled to be disbursed to students on May 28, 2020.
4. It is estimated 643 students will be eligible to participate in programs under Section 484 in Title IV of the Higher Education Act of 1965 and thus eligible to receive Emergency Financial Aid Grants to students under the CARES Act. To be eligible, students must have completed the FAFSA, not been enrolled exclusively in online courses as of March 13, 2020, and submitted the Murray State College Self Certification Form.
5. As of May 20, 2020 Murray State College has not disbursed any funds to students. Funds are scheduled to be disbursed to students on May 28, 2020.
6. Each eligible student will be given an initial grant of \$400.
