Your 2021-2022 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) was selected for review in a process called verification. To verify that you provided correct information, we will compare your FAFSA with the information on this institutional verification document and with any other required documents. If there are differences, your FAFSA information may need to be corrected. You and a parent, whose information was reported on the FAFSA must complete and sign this institutional verification document, attach any required documents, and submit the form and other required documents to the financial aid office. We may ask for additional information, if necessary, for clarification. If you have questions about verification, contact the financial aid office as soon as possible so that your financial aid will not be delayed. If needed, MSC will submit corrections electronically to the Department of Education. Once you submit the requested documents, please do not make any corrections to your FAFSA unless you are instructed to do so by the MSC Financial Aid Office.

### B. Household Information

List the people that your parent(s) will support between July 1, 2021 and June 30, 2022. Include:

- Yourself, your parent/stepparent(s), and your parent(s) dependent children (if your parent(s) provide more than half of the child's support, or if they would be required to give parental information when applying for federal aid). Include other people as part of your family **ONLY** if they lived with your parent(s) and got more than half of their support from your parent(s) at the time you completed your student aid application **AND** will continue to get more than half their support from July 1, 2021 through June 30, 2022. Any parent who lives in the household with the student is required to provide all information on the FAFSA, regardless of marital status.
