MSC Vaccine Incentive Rules

- Each student must submit a vaccination card or state vaccine digital record to be placed in the drawing. Each student must be fully vaccinated and provide proof of vaccination against COVID-19. Vaccination records must be clear and legible.
- By providing vaccination records, students give MSC staff permission to internally document and verify the following details of the vaccination card:
 - 1st and 2nd dose lot number
 - 1st and 2nd dose administration location
 - 1st and 2nd dose date
- May fill out an exemption form to participate in the drawings
- Students must be currently enrolled.
- Winning names will be drawn by Student Affairs staff each week.

Winners will be contacted by Student Affairs using your MSC email address once eligibility has been verified. The winner must respond to notification of the win within 10 business days or they will be disqualified and a new winner will be chosen, based on the established judging criteria.

Anyone who receives any prize valued at \$600 or more will receive an IRS 1099 form and will be responsible for the taxes on the gift. International students who receive any prize will receive an IRS 1042 form and will be responsible for the taxes on the gift. Some prizes may affect a student's financial aid package. Prizes are not transferable. Students who accept a prize agree to allow their name and/or likeness to be used to publicly announce their prize status. Prizes may be subject to certain date restrictions. Gift cards and prizes must be picked up at one of the MSC Campus locations.
