What is the Fast Track Lab option?

We know it may be difficult finding a facility with some species of animal. Therefore, students who are in applicable classes have the option to complete required clinical tasks that pertain to Bovine & Small Ruminant, Equine, and Exotic & Laboratory species at a Fast Track Lab as opposed to finding their own OCCI site.

How long does it take to complete a Fast Track Lab?

The Fast Track Labs are designed to be completed in about 3 days. During this time students experience hands-on training in order to complete their required skills.

Everything they will need for to complete Bovine, Small Ruminant, Equine, Exotic, and Laboratory animal clinical skills will be in one unified location.
