Outcomes Information for the most recent two years the following information is provided:

- Graduation rates for 2023 to 2025: 2023 = 75%, 2024 = 76.92, and 2025 = 86.6%. This data has been reported to CAPTE and is based on the completion of students offered a position in the class.
- Over ninety percent (> 90%) of students who are successful in the 1st semester (spring) achieve success in the technical year of the PTA program.
- Graduates during the 2024/2025 period have an 100% ultimate pass rate on the NPTE licensure examination. The Class of 2025 still have one student yet to take.
- Graduates who sought employment report finding jobs within 3 months of graduation. The employment rate is calculated based on those graduates who were seeking employment and found employment (FT, PT, or contract) within 12 months of graduation. Graduates from these classes report high job satisfaction (100%) on graduate surveys for most recent graduating class who have been surveyed (Class of 2024).
- Supervising PTs and employers report graduates performing at appropriate entry-level and that they would hire a graduate from the MSC PTA program again. (>95%)

* The Class of 2025 has one student yet to take the NPTE and will test in January 2026.

** The employment rate includes those licensed graduates who sought employment and who found employment (FT, PT, Contract) as identified by the graduate survey and state licensure identification of workplace. The employment rate for one-year post-graduation will be posted once graduate survey data is received. Class of 2025 will participate in graduate surveys in summer 2026.
